Impossibilities of Stationary Ordinal Equity

Abstract

The purpose of this paper is to show new impossibility results on intergenerational equity. In an infinite time-horizon setting, we investigate two cases imposing ordinal equity concepts such as *envy-freeness* and *egalitarian-equivalence*, and demonstrate that neither of them is compatible with the requirement of the *stationarity* of social preferences. Our results imply that the passage of time should effect an equitable social preference. Therefore, any social policy satisfying intergenerational equity contradicts stationarity.
